## Tournament History

The first Municipal Amateur Golf Championship was held in 1981. James H. Fyke started the tournament to recognize a true city golf champion in Nashville. From the outset the championship was an overwhelming success, boasting a field of 300 participants and a waiting list in its inaugural year. Due to the growing number of women golfers, a women's division was added in 1992. As the women's division continued to grow it became strong enough to stand alone and in 1995 the Ladies Municipal Golf Championship was established. This year we are celebrating the 15th anniversary of the tournament and it continues to be one of Middle Tennessee's most respected golf events.

## Tournament Information July 31 – August 1, 2010

**Format:** 36 hole stroke play competition. Players will qualify for flights by 18 hole total score and compete within their designated flight.

**Eligibility:** Applications are open to residents of the Nashville Metropolitan Statistical Area who meet the USGA definition of an amateur golfer. Persons applying for reinstatement to amateur status are not eligible. All competitors must be at least 18 years of age.

**Entry Deadline:** All players must file an application individually by the entry deadline— **July 26, 2010 – 4:30 p.m. CDT** to be eligible to compete in the championship. Time limit for entries means receipt in the Metro Parks Office. Entries limited to 180 players.

**Entry Fee:** \$100 Includes green fees & riding cart for both days, plus lunch for Sundays round. Enclose check payable to: Municipal Amateur Championship. Mail to: P.O. Box 120952 Nashville, TN 37212

**Rules of Golf:** Play will be governed by the USGA rules of Golf and Municipal Championship local rules.

**Pairings:** Pairing request will be considered on a first come first serve basis for the 1st round only.

**Refunds:** No refund will be issued after the entry deadline except for illness/injury. To receive a refund for this reason, the request must be made in writing and accompanied by a doctor's statement.

**Dress code:** Contestants must wear appropriate attire. Gym shorts, cut offs, shirts without collars are not acceptable. Shorts must be Bermuda type in length. Traditional type spikes are prohibited at all tournament courses.

**Conduct code:** Penalties for breach of sportsmanship code (to include but not limited to property damage, abusive language, club throwing, excessive drinking or gambling) may include censure, disqualification or revocation of playing privileges.

**Committee:** Any dispute or doubtful point on the rules shall be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final. The Committee consist of: Kevin Forte, Loren Personett, Fred Bryant, Wayne Evans, Barry DeVault, Troy Hendrickson, Daryl Edens and Rob Lent.
