Tournament requirements in brief:

In order to participate, all registrants will be required to have an equivalent of at least two (2) 18-hole rounds posted in the current year's handicap record. Scores must be posted before the July 1st handicap revision; members with a trend or local handicap exceeding 40.4 will not be eligible to participate in the stroke play division, but may be a member of a scramble team.

Stroke Play & Scramble Divisions: Below is the adjusted handicap range for stroke play and the corresponding individual handicap factor for scramble team participants:

<u>Handicap Index Range</u>	<u>Stroke Play Flight</u>	<u>Indv. Scramble Factor</u>
0 – 12.0	Championship	+2
12.1 – 19.0	First	+1
19.1 – 25.0	Second	0
25.1 – 32.0	Third	-1
32.0 – 40.4 (or higher for scramble)	Fourth	-2

Players on scramble teams with handicap index factors of +1, 0, -1, or -2 will play the same yardages as 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th flight stroke play competitors.

Only one member of a scramble team shall have a handicap index of 12.0 or less based on the established handicap revision date of July 1, 2010.

The total scramble team index factor shall fall between **+2 and -5**.

Don't let all these requirements scare you off! The main point is...you will play with women at a similar skill level as your own. We want to make this fun, safe and learning experience for those that have never competed in an "official" tournament. Here's your chance to try it out. I think you'll find that it is fun!
