### Turf Talk

Summer time is here! We have been fairly lucky with the few rainy days we have had this year. The maintenance crew has been very busy trying to get the golf course ready for summer. Preemerge and spring fertilizer has been applied to reduce weeds and improve turf quality. We are also in the process of applying gypsum to the entire course. This should reduce compaction and allow more of the accumulated salts to leach through the soil profile which intern will enhance turf conditions. We will continue to rotate our traffic control ropes around the course to also help with the compaction problems. We are also back in full swing when it comes to our regular mowing and maintenance on the course. Everyone should start to see a more consistent schedule on when things are completed. For example, greens will be mowed everyday, tees will be mowed two to three times a week, and bunkers should also be raked two to three times per week. We have also just recently applied our second application of fertilizer. You should also consider doing so for your home lawn if you haven't already. Soil temperatures are now high enough that your lawn will be actively growing, requiring fertilizer about every 30 to 45 days. Try to stick with a 3:1:2 ratio on you fertilizer like a 21-7-14 analysis.

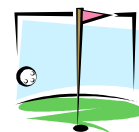
Like playing POKER? We will be having several poker tournaments & poker games now at Harbor Lakes. Call me for all details...
