

Individual Low Net	This is an individual event. Players will play against others within their flight. So all A players will be in the A flight, B players in the B flight and so on. The winners will be based on the lowest net scores in each flight. Scores from this event are postable scores for handicap purposes.
Quota	This is an individual event. Players will play against others within their flight A/A, B/B and C/C depending on the number of players who sign up. Points are awarded for gross scores. A players quota is calculated as follows: 39 - Players Handicap = Quota. Points for a hole are as follows: Bogey = 1, Par = 2, Birdie = 4, Eagle = 8 and Double Eagle = 12. The player's score is their total points - the players quota. Scores from this event are postable scores for handicap purposes.
Stableford	This is an individual event. Players will play against others within their flight A/A, B/B and C/C depending on the number of players who sign up. Points are awarded for net scores. Points for a hole are as follows: Bogey = 1, Par = 2, Birdie = 3, Eagle = 4 and Double Eagle = 6. Scores from this event are postable scores for handicap purposes.
Stableford – Power Holes	<p>This is an individual event. Players will play against others within their flight A/A, B/B and C/C depending on the number of players who sign up. Points are awarded for net scores. Points for a hole are as follows: Bogey = 1, Par = 2, Birdie = 3, Eagle = 4 and Double Eagle = 6. Power hole scoring means we will pick 4 holes to be Power Holes. On 3 of the power holes, a net birdie or better will count for double points. One hole will count for triple points for a net birdie or better.</p> <p>Cimarron Power Holes: 3, 7, 11 Are the double point holes, 18 is the triple point hole. Desert Springs Power Holes: 3, 8, 11 Are the double point holes, 17 is the triple point hole. Granite Falls North: 4, 8, 11 Are the double point holes, 18 is the triple point hole. Granite Falls South: 3, 8, 15 Are the double point holes, 18 is the triple point hole. Scores from this event are postable scores for handicap purposes.</p>
2 Man Best Ball	This is a 2 man team event. The team score is the best net score of the 2 players on each hole. Flights will be A/A, B/B and C/C. Number of flights will be based on the number of players who sign up. Scores from this event are postable scores for handicap purposes.
4 Man Lone Star	In this event, each play plays their own ball. Each player will be the Lone Star on the following holes. The A player's score must count on the lowest 6 handicap holes. The B players score must count on the next 5 lowest handicap holes. The C players score must count on the next 4 lowest handicap holes. The D players score must count on the 3 remaining holes. The team score is the best net score plus the lone star players score. Scores from this event are postable scores for handicap purposes.

4 Man 1 Low Gross 1 Low Net	In this event all players play the own ball. The team score is made up of the best combination of the best low gross and low net score. A player's score can only count for either the gross or net score but not both. Teams will be made up of an A, B, C and D player based on players handicaps. Scores from this event are postable scores for handicap purposes.
Shamble	This is played as a 2 man team event. Flighting will be A/A, B/B and C/C depending on the number of players. Each player will play a tee shot and then the team will pick the best drive and hit the next shot from there. After that, each player will play their own ball into the green. Each player will get 80% of his handicap. A minimum of 4 drives will be required in a 2 man game for each player. In a 4-man game, no player may have more the 9 drives. Scores are not postable for this event.
Scramble	<p>This is usually played as a 2 man team event. Flighting will be A/A, B/B and C/C depending on the number of players.</p> <p>It could be a 3 man or 4 man team event if the number of sign ups allow. It will be played from the White/Yellow Combination Tees. 3 and 4 man team games will be flighted A/B/C or A/B/C/D.</p> <p>Each player will play a tee shot and then the team will pick the best drive and hit the next shot from there. They will then continue to pick the best shot to play from and continue to do so until they are in the hole. The team handicap will be the total handicap of all the players. Players will receive the follow percentage of their handicap to determine the team handicap: A minimum of 4 drives will be required for each player. Team Handicaps follow the USGA guidlines for handicapping a scramble. Scores are not postable for this event.</p>
Individual Match Play	<p>The first event will be a qualifying tournament where all interested players will play in a low net individual event. This event will be held in the AM shotgun. We can accommodate 144 players which is 9 flights of 16 players. If there are less than 144 players, we will adjust the number of flights to accommodate the number of flights. We will divide the 16 players in each flight into two groups of 8 players. They will play each week until there is one winner in each 8 player grouping. The winner of each 8 player group will play the winner of the other 8 player group in the same flight. A final match will be played to determine the ultimate winner.</p> <p>There will not be a loser's bracket. Each player will pay \$5 for each week they play.</p>
Club Championship	To play in this tournament players will have to have 3 postable scores in the 2015 - 2016 Winter Season. This game is individual handicap stroke play, played the same as Low Net, and is played as a three day tournament. It starts on Wednesday, and the following days are determined by course availability (See winter League Schedule). This championship tournament is scheduled towards the end of our Winter League to establish Sun City Grand Men's Club Champions for each of the respective flights for a net winner

	<p>We will have a scratch flight for this tournament playing from the White Tees. The winner will be the lowest gross score and the Club Champion. There will be a play off if a tie exists for this flight only.</p> <p>Scores from this event are postable scores for handicap purposes as tournament scores.</p>
Pinehurst	<p>Both players tee off. Player A plays Player B's drive, and vice-versa. Each player hits the second shot. They then choose which of the second shots they wish to play. From that point until the ball is holed they play only one ball in an alternate shot format.</p>
Member / Member	<p>During the Winter Season, the Member Member will be played on consecutive days (Wed & Thur). During the Summer Season, the Member Member will be played on consecutive Wednesdays. If you cannot play both days, please do not sign up.</p> <p>Formats for this tournament will be combinations of 2 Man Scramble, Pinehurst, 2 Man Best Ball or Both Best Balls. The combinations used will be on the Individual Tournament Sign Up Sheets.</p> <p>Example - The first day could be a 2 Man Scramble and the second day would be 18 Holes of Pinehurst.</p> <p>Don't have a partner, sign up anyway and we will do our best to find you one.</p>
