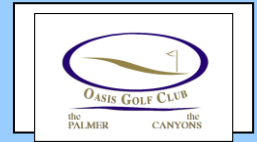

# Beach Party

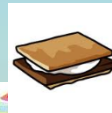
It's the start of the season with a Beach Party fest,

## COURSE CARE: WE NEED YOUR HELP

The over seeding of the golf courses seems to be very successful this year, and now we are asking for your help in keeping the golf courses as good as we can. Golf carts, bunkers, ball marks, tee divots and general course etiquette are all of our responsibilities. With your help we can keep the golf course in great playing condition.



**Golf carts:** Nothing can cause more damage to golf courses than the improper use of golf carts. The maintenance staff spends numerous hours moving signs and ropes in order to distribute cart traffic evenly throughout the golf course. We dislike the signs and ropes as much as you do. In a perfect world we would not have any signs or ropes on the golf course. With your help maybe we can reduce the wear areas on the course. Keeping carts on paths around all tee and greens would be appreciated. Sometimes much of the wear area around the greens is due to cart traffic. Obey the cart signs and ropes in order to reduce wear in weak areas. Avoid wet or damaged areas, and with a little extra help we can all enjoy a better golf course.

**Ball Marks:** It's every golfer's responsibility to repair their ball mark and others. This shows respect for the game, the other golfers, and the golf course. The proper way to repair a ball mark is to knit the turf back together rather than just lifting up the mark. The knitting together, just like laying sod will help the mark heal quicker. **Filling Divots:** Filling in your divots shows respect for the players, the game, and the course. If everyone filled their divot and one additional we would all benefit. The key is to not overfill the divot which waste material, dulls mowers and will eventually create uneven surfaces. Some of our small tee boxes have this problem which we continually are working on.

**Bunkers:** All golfers should rake the bunker after playing their shot. Again it shows respect for the players, the game, and the course.

The theme here seems to be if all golfers showed a little more respect for the golf course it would be beneficial to all of us. We are asking for your help to take that extra second and help improve your golf course. If every golfer had the mentality to leave the course better than they found it we would all enjoy better playing surfaces. Thanks for your help. Have a great golf season.

When we played couple's golf on Thursday, Terry mentioned how on #10 Palmer he might as well have a BARCO lounge over in "the hole" on the right where his drive tends to end up so often. So...I told Pat that we need to set up a lounge chair out there on Saturday and put his name on the chair. I also told her to bring his favorite beverage (Dewar's scotch).
